The FY 2024 Top 10 AEC opportunities total contract value is more than **\$38.7B**, consisting of prime contract opportunities from a variety of agencies and industry segments.

This report reveals key trends and patterns in the procurements as compared to prior years to assist vendors in their business development.

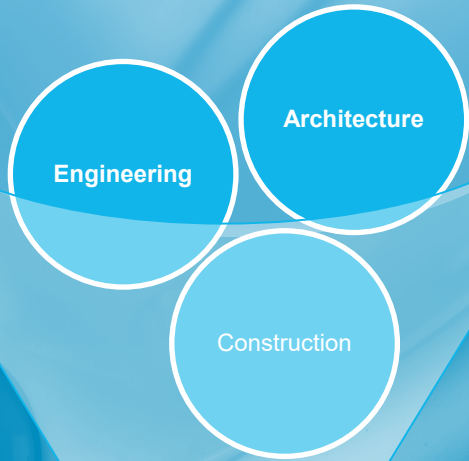

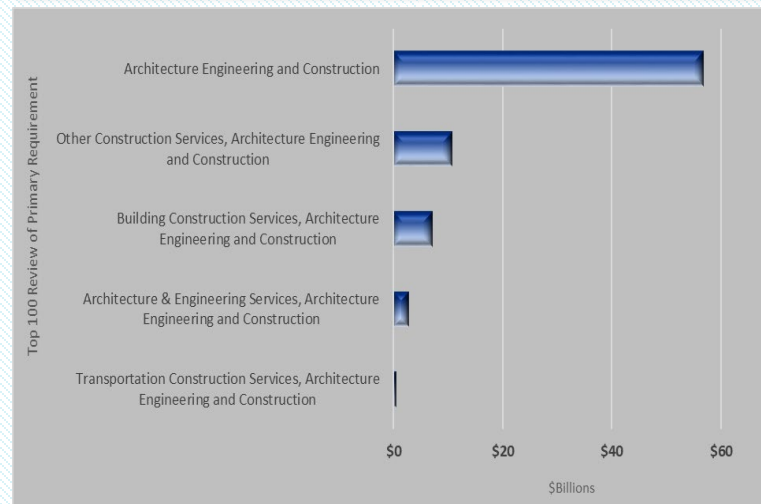

Place of Performance Highlight:

CONUS/US (72%) accounts for most of the upcoming requirements within the Top 100 review. There are (8) coming out of Guam and a handful that are noted as OCONUS and OCONUS/CONUS demands (19%).



Competitive Landscape:

The majority have yet to be determined. However, there are upwards of (30) that have and noted as F&O/UNR while (10) are reported as a mixed approach to awards including Small Business.



Additional Insight:

The majority of which are being allocated for Public Safety and General Purpose projects. At a much lower # there are just a few for Health & Social Services, Development, and the Transportation sectors.

GENERAL CONTRACTING

- **Naval Facility Engineering Systems Command Southwest (NAVFAC SW)** – solid path for more opportunities
- **Extraction and Recovery Projects (Gallium)**
- **BABA:** Well over 20K projects and awards in turn creating more AEC related jobs w/the Govt which now requires that all construction materials are made in America
- **Green Construction Initiatives** (still a priority)
- Some **segments** may be more bullish than others, coupled with factors ranging from inflation to supply chain issues. QN: Contingent on the project(s) some of which may continue to affect the industry overall in the coming fiscal year

SUBCONTRACTING

- Yes, subcontracting is a 'thing' and it will remain to be so for as long as deemed necessary in the completion of plans and projects by GCs. Every business is not equipped or interested in being a prime; **let's debunk that myth.** Its more important for businesses to get in and do what they do well at every size. Subc. contracts cover the gamut: Planning and Design, Drywall, Electrical, HVAC, Extraction. Site Prep, Concrete, Structural & Framing, Painting, Plumbing, etc.
- **There's an Org structure between contractors on a construction project:** Owner, General Contractors, Subcontractors, and Sub-subcontractors

INDUSTRY TRENDS

- **How to take you're A/E/C firm to the next level:** Be sure to concentrate on the emerging federal market and adhere to the pillars approach for implementation, annually. **For example:** (BIM 3D to 7D), Virtual Augmentation, Blockchain, Digital Twin, ongoing 3D Printing, 3D Laser Scanning, Drone Usage, Robotics, AI, IoT, and 4D Simulation.
- For Architects, Engineers, and Builders, **new technologies are making it easier** than ever to create or restore old/new buildings (incl. design components).

SECURE TECHNOLOGY

- Precise construction software and services are imperative – both enable the efficient completion of a project(s), starting from design to the execution phase to meet Fed. demands
- **Zero Trust Architecture (ZTA)** - 7 Pillar Approach with end-to-end security parameters and interoperability (priority)
- **Artificial Intelligence** - The Impact on the Construction Industry (fluid and a must to some degree moving forward)
- The lack of new technology impacts scheduling, budgets, quality and safety measures. Be an expert vendor who understands the critical nature to further ensure plans and projects are completed on time and on budget.

COMPETITIVE LANDSCAPE

- Due to evolving federal demands this is now a hyper-competitive **market for talent** in the AEC industry and will continue to be so over the next 5yrs, respectively.
- We're going to continue to see **labor cost** meet or exceed between 7-10%
- **M&A** – A/E firms that successfully integrate **disruptive technologies** into their businesses will see their values hold, if not increase. Construction acquisitions are contingent upon several other factors.
- The next 4-5 years should prove to be fruitful for design or architecture firms with the right partnerships

BUDGETS & INDEX

- **New investments** reaching \$335M, a \$50 million increase above the 2023 enacted level advocates and pushes for the evidence-based revitalized earn-and-learn model
- **Justice40 Initiative** – (33) projects to help Disadvantaged and Tribal communities address several challenges, included in the \$35M allocation
- **Critical Veteran Medical Facilities and Research Facilities** (new engineering and construction projects)
- **Civil Works Programs** - \$1B to include hyper-focused construction projects out of USACE.

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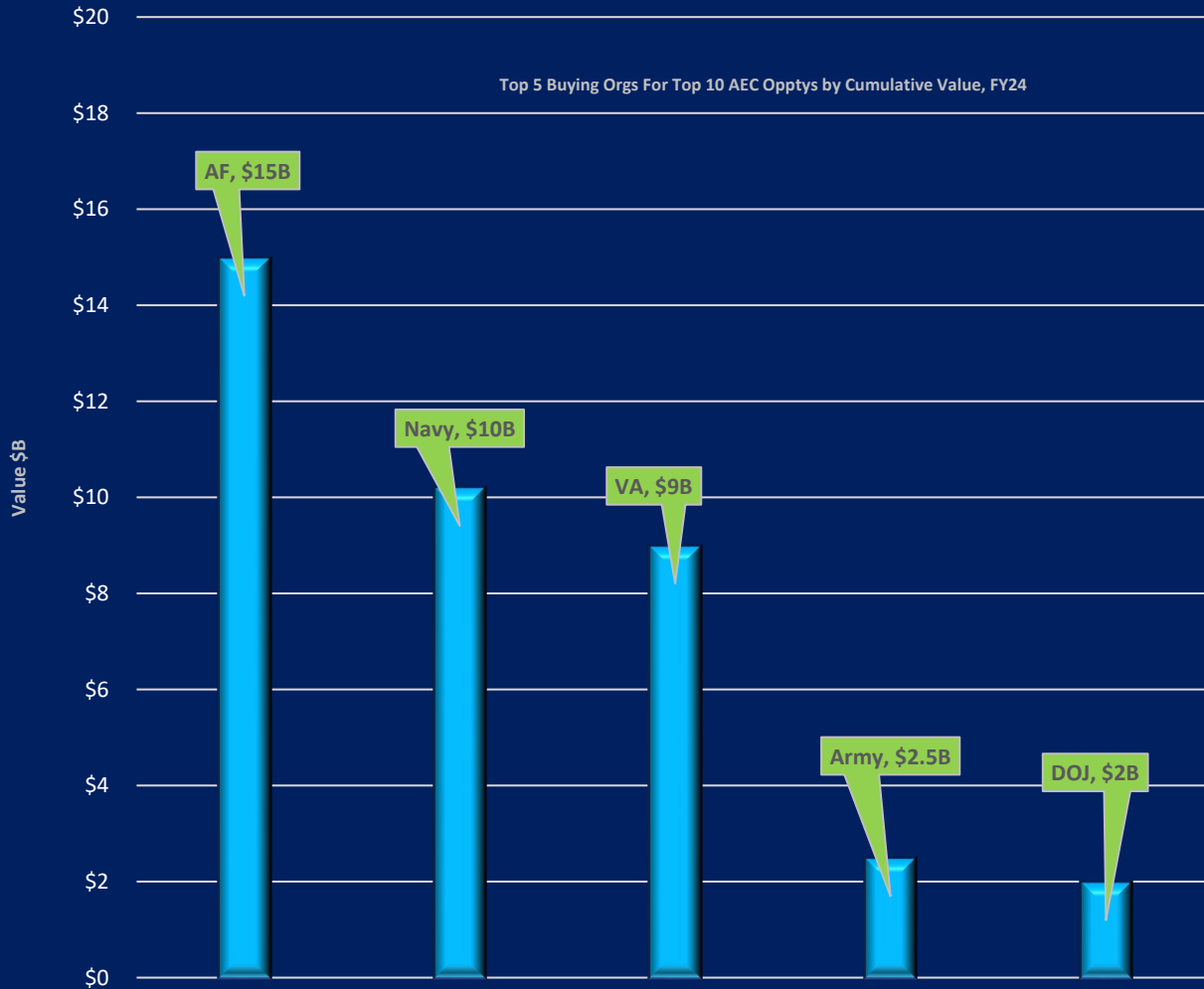
FY24 Top 10 Federal AEC Requirements



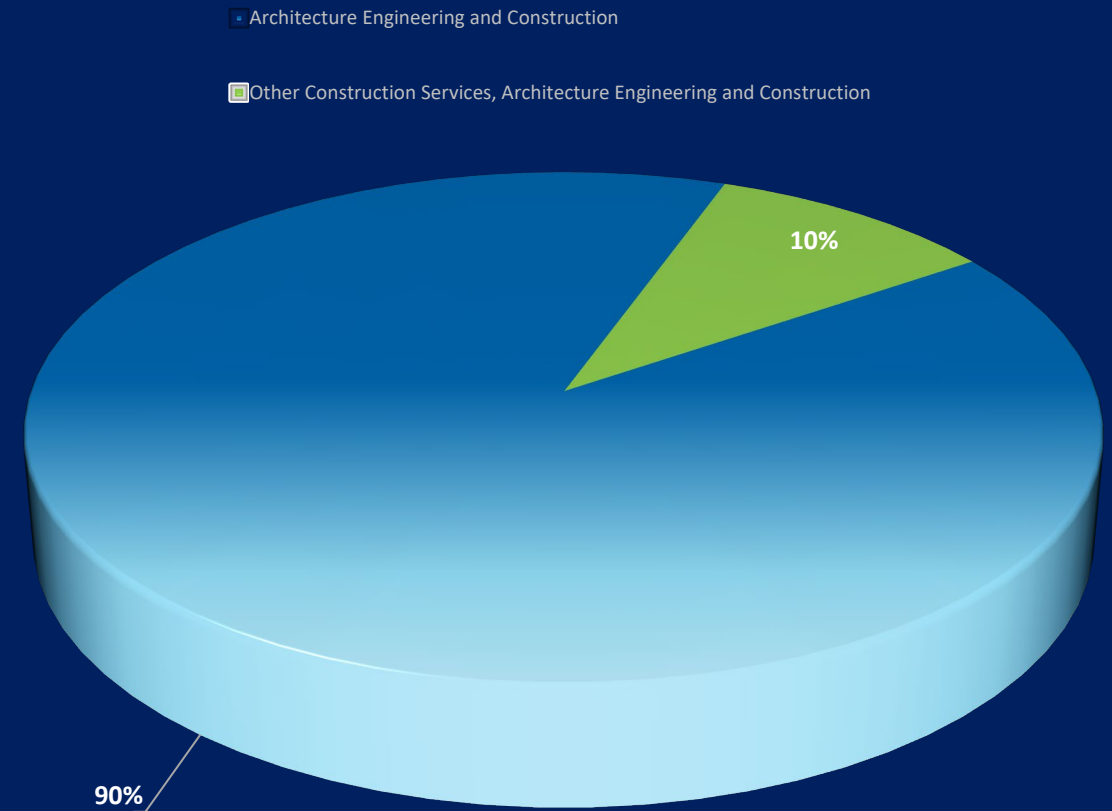
Top 5 Buying Organizations & Primary Requirements

Based on Top 10 Federal AEC Government Demands

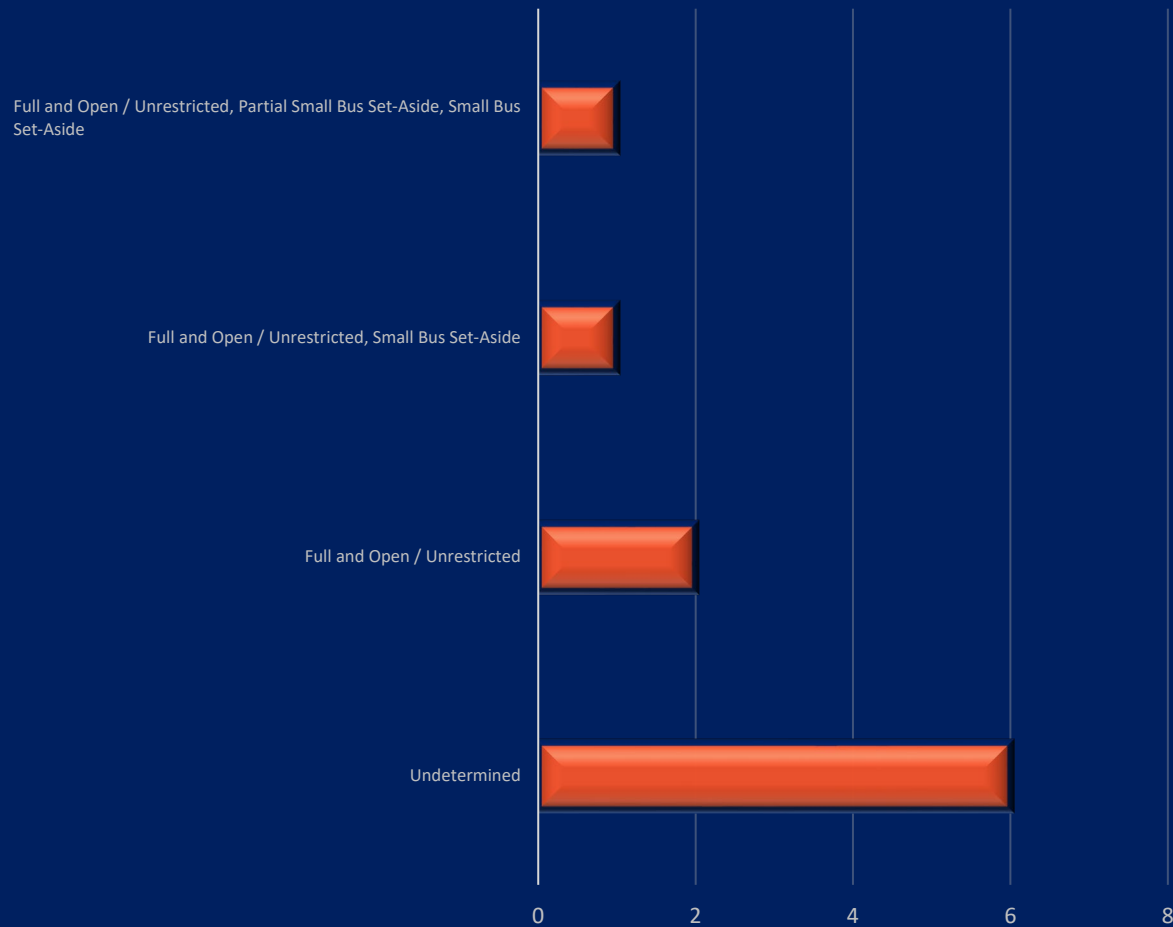

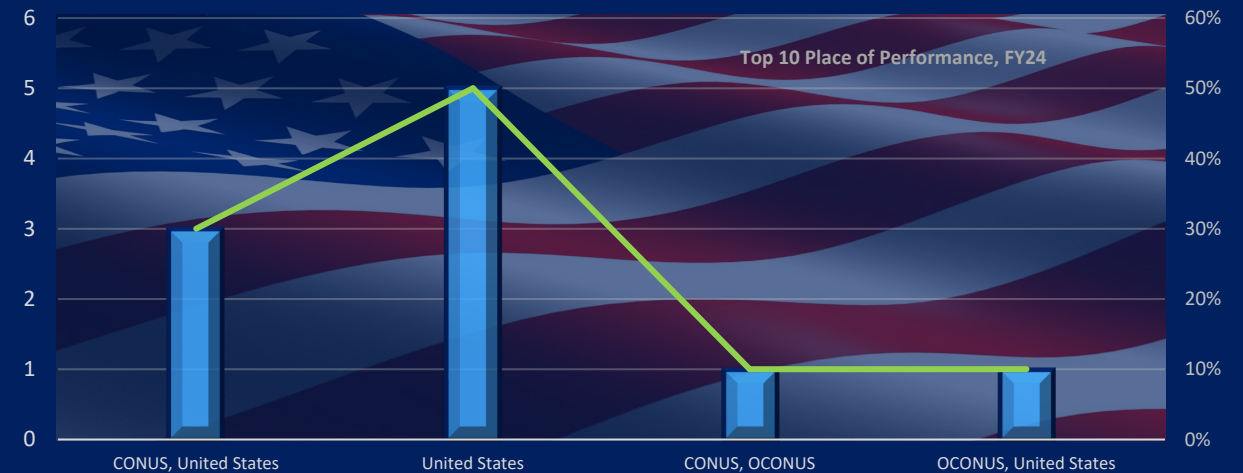
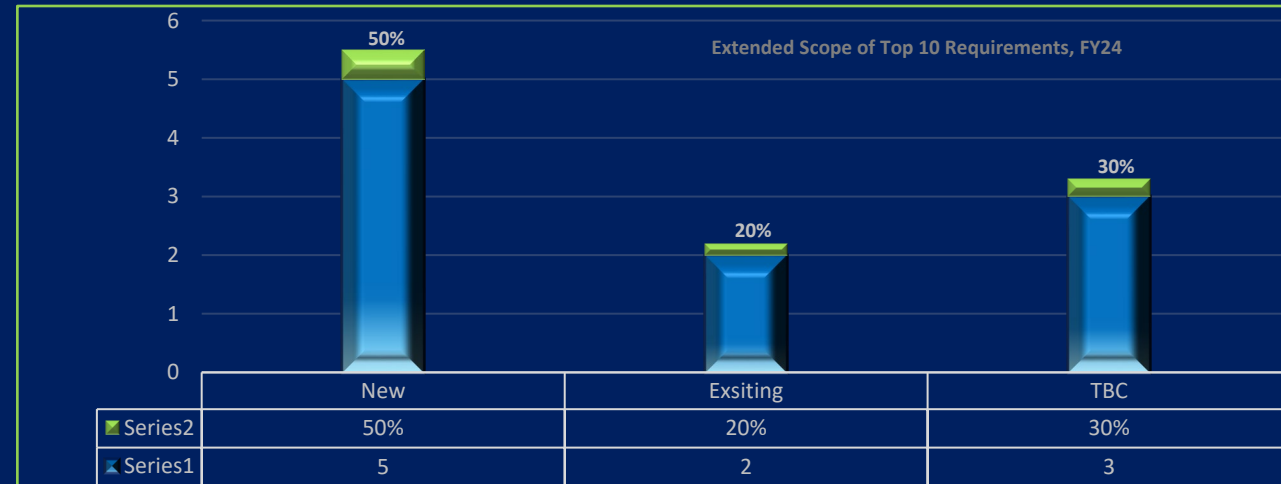
PERCENTAGE OF TOP 10 PRIMARY REQUIREMENTS, FY24

The Top 10 Opportunities are attributed to more than \$38B in Govt demands. 40% of the Solicitations are slated to be released in Q1FY24 while the remaining 60% are to take place on or after Jan 2024 – spec. Q2FY24.



Projected Award dates span from April 2024 to February 2025. Three major requirements are slated to be awarded in July 2024.

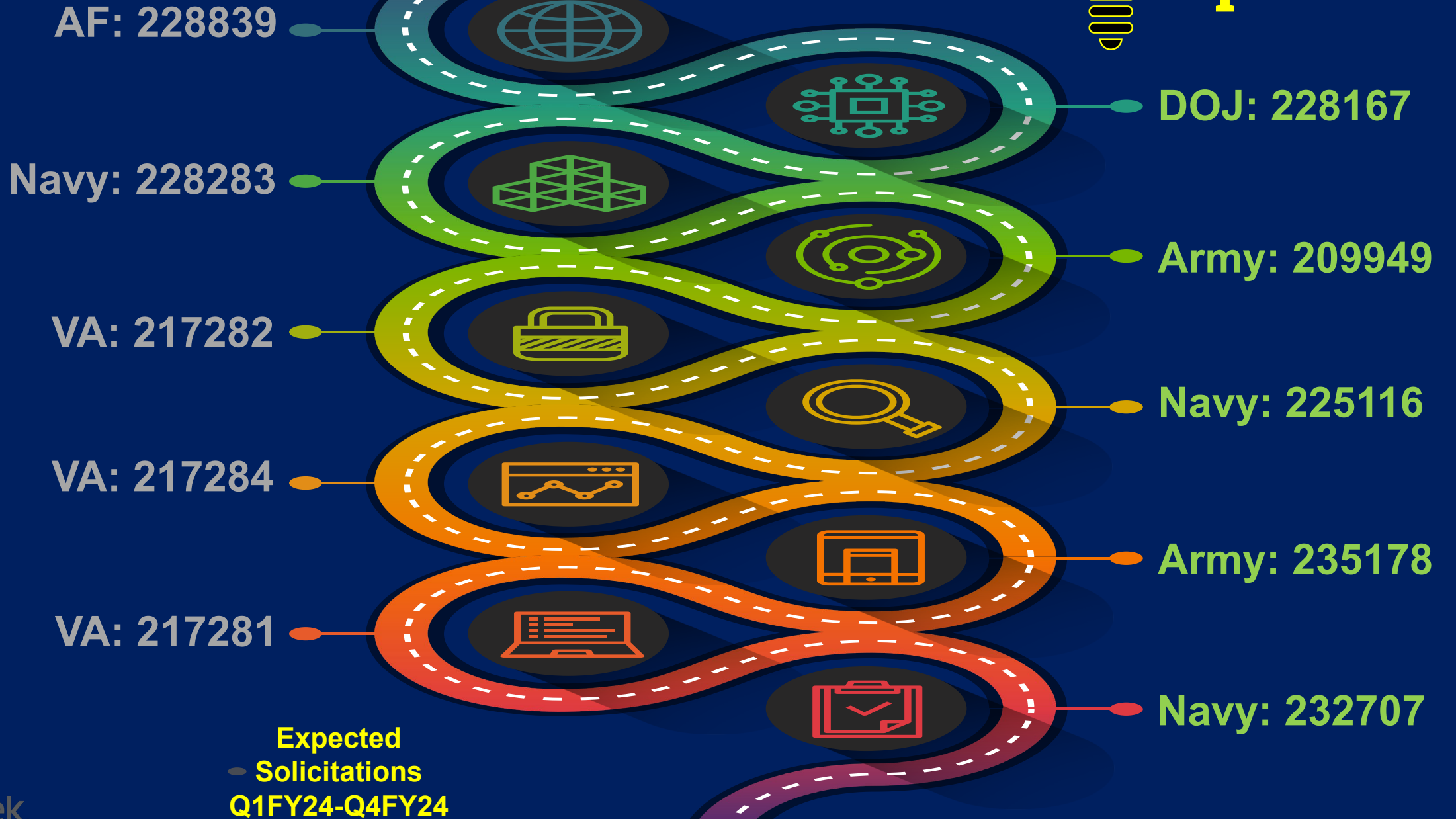

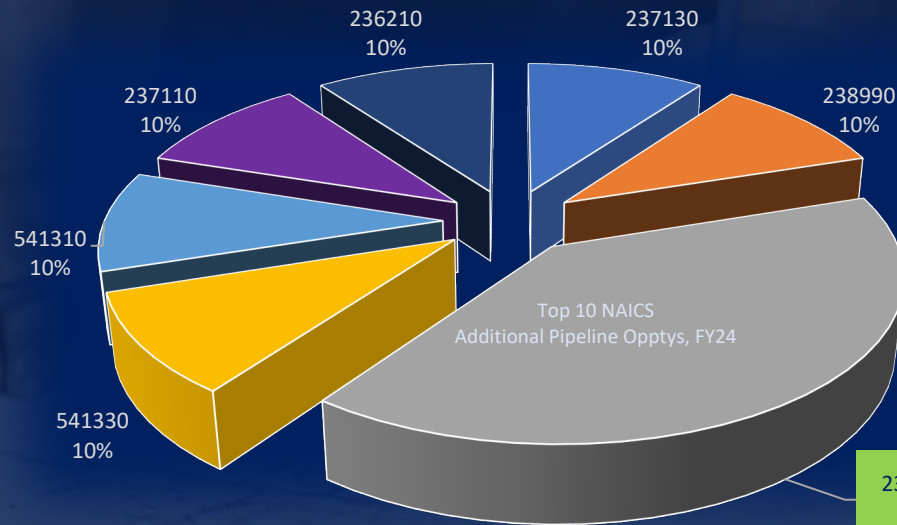

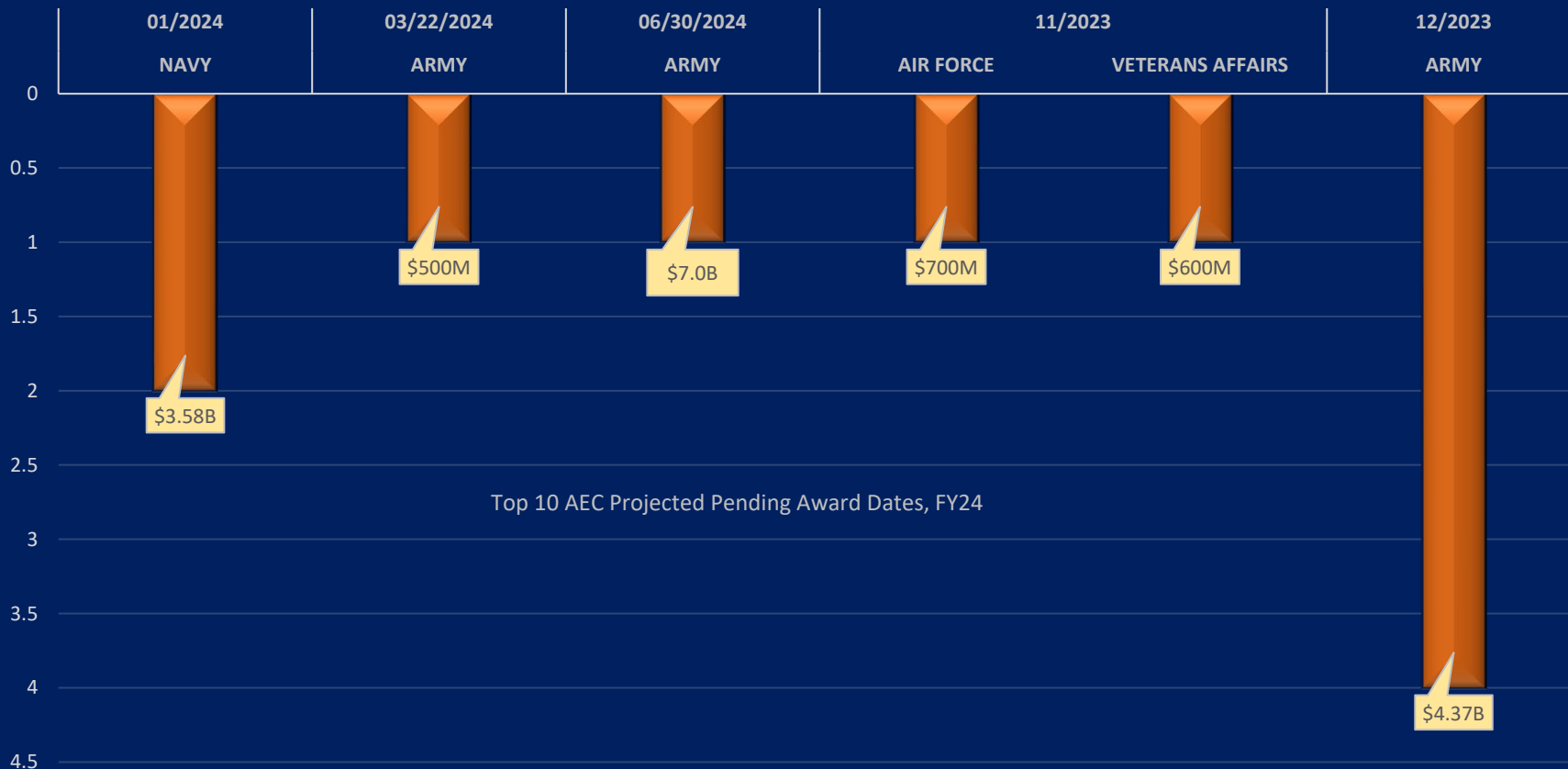
